

2008 MYAS UMPIRES CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1) I will demand a sports environment that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all MYAS/USSSA sporting events.
- 2) I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, contest administrators and fellow officials at every game.
- 3) I will remember that the game is for the kids - not the adults, coaches or officials.
- 4) I will do my best to make sure that youth sports are a FUN and POSITIVE experience.
- 5) I will not use profanity.
- 6) I will communicate my concerns through the proper channels in a dignified manner.
- 7) I will master both the rules of the game and the mechanics necessary to enforce the rules, and will exercise authority in an impartial, firm and controlled manner.
- 8) I will uphold the honor and dignity of the profession in all interaction with athletes, coaches, tournament administrators, colleagues and the public.
- 9) I will be punctual and professional in the fulfillment of all contractual obligations.
- 10) I will remain mindful that my conduct influences the respect that athletes, coaches and the public hold for the profession.

PENALTY

Any violation of the above Code of Conduct may result in a temporary or permanent banishment from any MYAS or USSSA sponsored events.
